- KMSYA and KMS (total 16 hectares) current sugar planting will be harvested for second and third time in 2023.

A REMINDER that all MMS orphans are fostered by relatives - KINDRED FOSTER CARE. This ethos is promoted throughout the world as the best care for orphaned children. Being cared for in their own culture, in their own environment, among people who hopefully best understand them and their needs.

Since 1996, 52 young adults have progressed through Mustard Seed.
